Dear Parents,

We would like to give you some information about the «Back to school, sharing store» project. This project is designed to help low-income families for whom school supplies are sometimes very difficult to obtain. The «Sharing Store» will be held at the school on the same days as the "back to school" packages are to be picked up (Monday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 - 9am-6pm and Tuesday August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017 - 9am to 3:00pm.)

The Sharing store will provide families with all of their child's school supplies at a cost of \$15, or \$20, if you wish to purchase a new school bag. This is a community-based project that believes in certain values, such as dignity, sharing and solidarity. The realization of this project is in part due to the cooperation of the Greater Gatineau community services and the participation of Centraide Outaouais.

The Sharing Store is for all the low-income families with children in Greater Gatineau Elementary School. Please note that you must submit a copy of your 2016 income tax receipt.
